In the second week of March AVTECH together with UK Met Office attended the Flight Ops conference in Miami where Norwegian presented the latest numbers from operating the Cruise Profile Optimizer. For the December to February period we continue to see a consistent savings potential of up to 1.63% of cruise fuel in Norwegians operation and we can see that the numbers are quite consistent throughout the months.
