AVTECH, the UK Met Office and IATA webinar

Avtech held a webinar 24th of September about proFLIGHT weather app at AircraftIT. The webinar explained proFLIGHT's integration of aviation's leading Met Office High-Resolution Global Weather model, with integrated IATA Turbulence Aware data to provide pilots with a multi-layered, highly accurate real-time weather and flight path optimization solution which can be updated at any time during flight preparation or in flight. With this information at their fingertips, pilots can be better prepared for their flights, and passengers can be assured of a more timely and comfortable flying experience.

Looking forward we are planning for the re-launch of proFLIGHT in the next coming weeks. The proFLIGHT app is now finally well-developed enough for being taken out of trial. This means that we are going to deploy paid subscriptions for the most complex features and weather layers that we provide in the app. There will still be a possibility for pilots to use the more basic features within the app for free.

The new version of proFLIGHT is updated with the following features:

- SNOWTAM and MOTNE decoder
- Better iPadOS14 compatibility
- NAT tracks compatibility for flight plan editor
- General performance improvements

As a continuation on the article that was released a video production in collaboration with the the UK Met Office focusing on the benefits of high-resolution weather applied in AVTECH's services are being produced. In addition, also as a follow-up to the video, a webinar is planned together with the Met Office, focusing on fuel saving and lowering CO2 emissions.
